Phil Grant received his undergraduate degree in Economics from the Virginia Military Institute. He received his law degree from the University of Texas at Austin. During his eight years as a prosecutor in Harris County, Texas he specialized in child sexual abuse and public integrity cases. He moved to Williamson County where he served as a chief felony prosecutor in the 26th and 368th District Courts while handling civil litigation matters including asset forfeitures for the local District Attorney's office. He was named Child Abuse Prosecutor of the Year in 2007 by the Williamson County Children's Advocacy Center and Child Protective Team. In 2009, he accepted the position as First Assistant District Attorney in Montgomery County, Texas.

He is currently Past-President of the Board of Children's Safe Harbor (the Montgomery County Child Advocacy Center), on the Board of Directors for the Conroe Noon Lions Club, and was appointed to the Guardianship Certification Board for the State of Texas by the Texas Supreme Court. He is Board Certified in Criminal Law by the Texas Board of Legal Specialization and has over 100 first chair felony trials.

As the First Assistant District Attorney of Montgomery County District Attorney's Office, Phil is responsible for the day to day management of the office including the preparation and presentation of the annual budget. He also supervises the Public Integrity attorneys and support staff. He is a member of the Major Crimes and Police Integrity Response Team.

A former adjunct professor with Lone Star College and Texas State University, Phil Grant is an accomplished speaker and teacher who presents on a variety of issues throughout the state. He teaches training for local and regional law enforcement as well as presenting community interest topics to local school boards and parent teacher groups.
